WordUp word of the week: JUSTIFY

<u>How was this word chosen?</u> This is an academic word, the kind of word that takes *lots* of exposures to learn, and that children will need to know to read texts successfully in the years to come.



The Abound app gives your child 7 opportunities to hear and use the week's abstract word. For extra practice, here are 2 more questions about this week's word, **JUSTIFY**.

(**JUSTIFY** definition: to have a good reason for doing something or believing something; to show or prove that something is right.)

- I can **JUSTIFY** taking a nap in the middle of the day because I work very late at night. Do you think it is always **JUSTIFIED** to take a nap during the day, or do you think you need to have a very good reason? Why?
- When you're trying to save money, it's hard to **JUSTIFY** buying things you <u>want</u> but you don't really <u>need</u>. Let's try to think of things that we could **JUSTIFY** buying no matter what, and things we couldn't **JUSTIFY** buying.

This week's featured *TalkOn* question to inspire more TALK at home:

Try to stack five of the same kind of coins. What do you notice? Which part of the coin design helps make the same type of coins stack so well?
