WordUp word of the week: CONTRIBUTE

How was this word chosen? This is an academic word, the kind of word that takes lots of exposures to learn, and that children will need to know to read texts successfully in the years to come.



The Abound app gives your child 7 opportunities to hear and use the week's abstract word. For extra practice, here are 2 more questions about this week's word, **CONTRIBUTE**.

(CONTRIBUTE definition: to give something, often to people who need help; to add your help or ideas as part of a group trying to accomplish a project; to offer one's ideas or viewpoints in a conversation.)

- CONTRIBUTE means to give something to people who need help. Can we think of any people who need help? What kinds of CONTRIBUTIONS would help them feel better, or help solve their problems?
- When you're sitting around a table at lunch or dinner, do you like to CONTRIBUTE to the
 conversation, or do you prefer to just sit quietly? Do you think people at a table should all
 CONTRIBUTE to the conversation, or do you think people should be able to not talk if they
 don't want to talk?

This week's featured *TalkOn* question to inspire more TALK at home:

What if people put up framed pictures on the outside of buildings rather than the inside? How would it change your experience as you walked along a street?
