MEMORIALS

The School Committee recognizes that the death of a student, member of the staff, or prominent

community member is deeply felt by the school community. As places designed primarily to

support learning, school sites should not serve as the main venue for permanent memorials.

A memorial is anything that is established to remind people of a deceased person. Memorials

include, but are not limited to, plaques or signs, plantings or gardens, permanent structures, and

drives or fundraisers.

1. Permanent memorials within the District shall be limited in form to donations or

scholarships that support education, awareness, and prevention.

2. Permanent memorials in existence before the adoption of this policy can only be removed

by a vote of the School Committee.

3. The District reserves final say over any and all memorials and scholarships.
