- > FY23 A-B budget was "balanced" (funded by towns)
- > \$102.9M A-B budget was 3.2% increase from FY22
- > Assessment increases of 3.2% (ACT) and 4.6% (BOX)
- ➤ Boxborough enrollment trending proportionately higher
- ➤ Acton is against Proposition 2-1/2 Levy Limit
