## Foundation Budget and Student Opportunity Act (SOA)

- ABRSD is in "Hold Harmless" because our enrollment has dropped. We receive the minimum $\$ 30$ per student increase in Chapter 70 each year.
- The Student Opportunity Act will provide more Chapter 70 funding over the next several years, but not to districts who are in "Hold Harmless."
- We are $\$ 4 \mathrm{M}$ above the hold harmless threshold. We would need to increase about 350 students from current enrollment to be able to receive any SOA or Chapter 70 increases beyond the $\$ 30$ per student.
