




Multilingual Learners- Languages





2023-2024 Distribution of Multilingual Learners (K-12)




Increase in multilingual students at secondary level





MLE Program Across Grade Levels

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

- SEI Model (Push In/Pull Out services)

Student Proficiency and Progress

- **67%** made progress (MA = 43%)
- 27% attained proficiency (MA = 12%)

Monitoring Tools

- 1) Initial Identification with WIDA Screener
- District-Wide assessments such as Dibels, I-Ready, formative and summative assessments given by teachers. Whole child approach.
- 3) Statewide assessment results (ACCESS/MCAS)
- 4) Progress monitoring with WIDA Rubrics for all 4 language domains
- 5) Monitoring of success metrics (Drop-Out Rates, Grades, class placement, extra curricular involvement, referrals to special education).
- 6) Crosswalk between MLE, DEI, SEL SE, General Education

Budgetary Considerations

- Increase in ML population means that we need an increase in staffing at the elementary level to meet the recommended DESE service requirements.
- 2) Increase in staffing at the secondary level to manage caseloads and support general educators with bridging content gaps (introduce more co-teaching partnerships).
- 3) SLIFE programming considerations.
- 4) Increase in budget for translation/interpretation services.
- 5) Increase in Professional Learning for English Language Development Teachers/General Educators.
