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
Facilities Update

Community Partnership

- Acton Boxborough United Way (ABUW) is eager to support this project as it closely aligns with ABUW's mission.
- Developing a formal partnership where ABUW serves as a contracted service provider for the District to oversee and provide a range of identified services and supports
- United Way's Services and Roles:
 - Providing a warm welcome to the community
 - Helping residents find the resources when they need them
 - Making community resources accessible digitally
 - Supporting principals /counselors in providing non-school related help to families in need
 - Leveraging ABUW's relationships with community partners to bring services to families
 - Enriching community connections

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Funding Sources and Staffing

- Submitted \$100,000 earmark funding request to Senator Eldridge's state budget to further enhance facilities and increase staffing; received favorable updates thus far
- Allocated funds from dissolution of EDCO membership to begin the facilities upgrade
- Continuing role of current K-6 registrar and reallocating office to resource center
- Level of services through ABUW partnership is likely dependent on results of earmark request

Future Proposed Phases

Phase 2 may include:

- Donation center for families to collect items that they require for daily needs which can help alleviate some of the financial pressures faced by families. It can provide them with essential items that they may not be able to afford otherwise, and it can also offer a sense of community support during difficult times.
- Educational programming for families geared toward language acquisition, American culture and schooling.
- Health clinics, fairs, and functions that support community health education and access.
